3	<b>CUAET deadlines</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ <b>15 Jul 2023:</b> The deadline for Ukrainians to apply for the CUAET program from outside Canada is fast approaching.</li><li>➤ <b>31 Mar 2024:</b> Those with a CUAET visa have until that date to travel to Canada under the special measures to be eligible for various supports offered under CUAET.</li><li>➤ <b>31 Mar 2024:</b> Those with a CUAET visa have until that date to apply to extend or change their temporary status in Canada through the special measures.</li><li>➤ <b>31 Mar 2025:</b> Last day when Ukrainians and their family members who are in Canada temporarily can benefit from settlement services.</li></ul>

4	<b>Ukrainian Constitution Day</b>  <b>28 Jun 2023</b>	It is a public holiday celebrated since 1996. It commemorates the anniversary of the adoption of the new Constitution.  The first Constitution was written in 1710. Being the first constitution in Europe, it was notable for its profound democracy.
