3	15 Jul 2023 deadline	<p>Eligible applicants who are outside Canada have until July 15, 2023, to apply for a visa under CUAET.</p>
4	Kosov family	<p>The Kosov family has now moved to their rental accommodation. Furniture and household items were delivered on 30 Jun and 7 Jul. Thank you to those who contributed in-kind donations to help furnish the accommodation. 5	Project closure	<p>We started our Shuswap Support to Ukrainians project in March 2022. Thanks to the tremendous support of over 75 volunteers divided in 13 teams/focus areas, we have welcomed four families in our Shuswap community. Now that the four families have moved to rental accommodations and are on their way to becoming self-sustaining, we have reached the point where the Shuswap Support to Ukrainians project framework is no longer needed. The plan is therefore to close down the project on 31 Aug 2023. I estimate that it will take until end Dec 2023 to wrap up all the project documentation, write the final report and close the bank account.</p> <p>More details will be provided in the Mon 24 Jul biweekly update.</p> <p>Notwithstanding the closure of the project, Carole Landry and I will always remain available to help our Ukrainian families in any way we can.</p>
