3	BC Financial assistance	<p>On 29 Jun, the BC government announced that Ukrainian citizens arriving in BC under the federal Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) can now apply for hardship assistance from the province.</p> <p>Eligibility for hardship assistance is based on need and can be as much as \$935 per month (single person), as much as \$1,770 per month (family of four), as much as \$1,358.50 per month (single person with a disability) and as much as \$2,193.50 per month (family of four, one adult is a person with a disability).</p> <p>For the full story:</p> <p><a href="#">B.C. provides financial assistance for displaced Ukrainians   BC Gov News</a></p>
