4	Family arrivals	Three of our five families arrived in Aug 2022 (with additional family members who arrived in Nov and Dec 2022) for a total of 10 newcomers. Two of the three families have so far moved to their own accommodations in Salmon Arm.				
		Our two remaining families (9 newcomers) are expected to arrive in the Feb 2023 timeframe. Host accommodations are available for their arrival; one family will go to Canoe and one to Sorrento. This will bring our total number of newcomers to 19 (8 children and 11 adults).				
5	Disbursement of funds	We have so far allocated \$9,000. to each family. This amount is adjusted on a regular basis based on additional donations received. The 2022 disbursements are listed in the 2022 Annual Financial Statement. For the three families who have				

		arrived so far, the 2022 disbursements and the 2023 disbursements to date amount to 62% of the total allocations. Approximately 10% of the total funds are temporarily set aside for general support/contingency for activities that benefit all families (such as welcoming activities, attendance at fundraisers, transportation, emergencies, etc.). The unused funds will gradually be added to the family allocations in the coming weeks. Approximately 1% of the funds are allocated to administration (bank account and GoFundMe fees). So far, only 0.24% has been spent on administration since the majority of the services have been living in the Shuswap for approximately six months, Carole Laundry and I will be meeting with each family in the next couple of weeks to discuss how they are settling in, what additional help they need, lessons learned and to develop a plan to disburse their remaining funding allocation, based on their individual needs and timeline.
6	In-kind donations	The \$50,311. raised to date does not include the value of all the in-kind donations received. It is difficult to determine a value as it is a combination of new and used items. A quick search of the internet indicates that the average cost to furnish a one-bedroom apartment from scratch is around \$5,000. Thanks to the many in-kind donations received, we were able to furnish two three-bedroom apartments. We still have donated items stored in various locations in Salmon Arm, Sorrento and Blind Bay; finding storage continues to be a challenge. Agnes Nykiforuk, our In-kind Donations Coordinator, maintains an inventory of our remaining items.
